GENERAL DESCRIPTION:

Under direction, provides quality emergency services in the protection of life and property; acts without direct supervision and exercises independent discretion in meeting emergencies.

ESSENTIAL DUTIES:

- 1. Responds to fire alarms and assists with controlling and extinguishing fires.
- 2. Operates trucks, ladders, pumps, generators, and other related equipment.
- 3. Utilizes axes, ropes, bolt cutters, power tools, and related fire fighting equipment to assist in fire fighting operations.
- **Construction** Performs rescue and salvage operations.
- 5. Inspects, cleans, tests, and performs parts replacement on fire and safety equipment.
- 6. Performs adjustments on fire control systems.
- 7. Maintains equipment and work area in a clean, orderly, safe condition.
- 8. Lifts and moves victims of various weights and lifts up to eighty (80) pounds and moves thirty (30) yards of rescue tools, ladders, related emergency tools, etc.

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- 9. Follows all department safety practices and procedures.
- 10. Subject to on call twenty-four (24) hours a day, seven (7) days a week.
- 11. Maintains required licenses and/or certificates.
- 12. Demonstrates regular and predictable attendance.

OTHER DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

- 1. Attends workshops or seminars related to duties performed.
- 2. Performs other duties as assigned by supervisor.

KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS AND ABILITIES:

Knowledge of: geographic layout of jurisdiction; fire/emergency rescue techniques; department goals and objectives; safety practices and procedures; EMT rules and regulations; emergency medical care procedures; first aid practices; cardiopulmonary resuscitation; equipment, chemicals, and other materials used in custodial services; public relations; workplace safety.

Skill in: emergency medical equipment operation; rescue equipment.

Ability to: carry out detailed but basic written or oral instructions; interpret a variety of instructions in written, oral, picture, or schedule form; deal with a variety of variables within somewhat unfamiliar context; recognize unusual or threatening conditions and take appropriate action; exercise independent judgment; understand, interpret, and apply laws, rules, or regulations to specific situations; compile and prepare reports; communicate effectively; develop and maintain effective working relationships; demonstrate physical endurance; travel to and gain access to work site; lift, position, and move disabled or bedridden clients/patients; operates emergency vehicles, rescue equipment, computer, electronic equipment; lifts anal moves up to 80 pounds and moves 30 yards of equipment and tools.

- 4. Must perform physically (demanding work in hot (up to 400 degrees), humid (up to 100%) atmospheres while wearing equipment that significantly impairs body cooling mechanisms.
- 5. Ability to experience frequent transition from hot to cold anal from humid to dry atmospheres.
- 6. Ability to work in wet, icy, or muddy areas.
- 7. Ability to perform a variety of tasks on slippery, hazardous surfaces such as on rooftops or ladders.
- 8. Ability to work in areas where sustaining traumatic or thermal injuries is possible.
- 9. Ability to face exposure to carcinogenic dusts such as asbestos, toxic substances such as hydrogen cyanide, acids, carbon monoxide, or organic solvents either through inhalation or skin contact.
- 10. Ability to face exposure to infectious agents such as hepatitis B or HIV.
- 11. Ability to wear person protective equipment that weighs approximately 50 pounds while performing fire fighting tasks.
- 12. Ability to perform physically demanding work while wearing positive pressure breathing equipment with 1.5 inches of water column resistance to exhalation at a flow of 40 liters per minute.
- 13. Ability to operate in environments of high noise, poor visibility, limited mobility, at heights and in enclosed or confined spaces.
